Stronger Together: Building a Brighter Sierra Del Mar

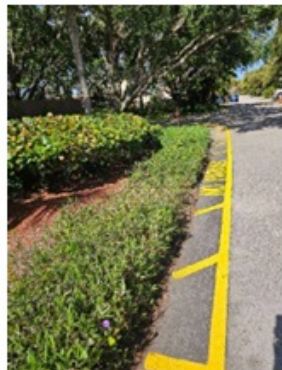

Birthday Party Programs:

Sugar Sand Park offers children fun and exciting birthday programs! Parents and children choose one of our wonderful age-appropriate programs for up to 20 kids! All parties will include the selected 1-hour program and an additional 45 minutes of celebration time (plus 15 minutes for cleanup). You will have access to our kitchen for use of the refrigerator, freezer, sink, and ice machine.

Sugar Sand Park Community Center will provide tables and chairs for up to 20 participants and up to 20 adults. Decorations, cakes, tableware, etc. are not supplied so don't forget your child's favorite theme or color!

Parties are offered on Saturdays and Sundays only, subject to Provider and room availability. Start and end times are firm. You and the Provider will have access to the room for setup/decorating no earlier than 12:30pm-1:30pm. The program will begin promptly at 1:30pm. You will then have the room from 2:30pm-3:30pm for the remainder of your celebration (cake, gifts, etc.) and cleanup (including removal of all decorations). The room must be vacated no later than 3:30pm.

Per City Ordinance ([Chapter 9, Article VII.-Waste Reduction](#)) the use of balloons, confetti and polystyrene foam (Styrofoam) is prohibited on City property. You can, however, decorate otherwise with colorful tablecloths, banners, streamers and other items.

A Birthday Party Reservation Request Form must be filled two weeks ahead of the party.
