Something Yummy!

Pumpkin-Cranberry Muffins

Adapted from Kosher by Design
Easy to make!

3 C bread flour or all-purpose flour
3 C sugar
1 1/2 t ground cinnamon
1/2 t baking powder
1 t baking soda
1 (15 oz) can of pumpkin (not pie filling)
1 C canola oil
3 large eggs
1/2 C sweetened dried cranberries
shelled pumpkin seeds

Preheat oven to 350 F. Line muffin tins with paper muffin liners and set aside. In the bowl of an electric stand mixer, mix the flour, sugar, cinnamon, baking powder and baking soda. Add the pumpkin, oil, eggs and cranberries. Mix on medium speed for 2 minutes. Pour the batter into the prepared muffin tins. Each cup should be filled about 2/3 of the way. Top each muffin with pumpkin seeds. Bake uncovered for 40-45 minutes or until a toothpick inserted into the center of one of the muffins comes out dry. Serve hot or at room temperature.
